



COUNSELLING DOCUMENTATION GUIDE

Madhya Pradesh NEET UG Documents

Every document a Madhya Pradesh candidate needs — the national papers every applicant must carry, plus the DME state-quota proofs and bonds. What each one is, how to get it, what it costs, and the mistakes that cost a seat.

Covers both pools. As a Madhya Pradesh candidate you are considered for the 85% state quota (DME, MP) and the 15% All India Quota (MCC). This guide is complete on its own — you do not need any other document to follow it.

Madhya Pradesh fences early rounds for locals and binds you with a heavy bond

You qualify for the MP state quota by being a permanent resident (mool nivasi) of Madhya Pradesh or by having passed both Class 10 and Class 12 from recognised MP schools. The state reserves its government and private state-quota seats for MP candidates in the early rounds. After allotment you execute bonds on stamp paper — including a seat-leaving bond reported at Rs.30 lakh for government colleges.

Two things to plan for in Madhya Pradesh

Domicile or 10+12 in MP. A Madhya Pradesh permanent-resident (mool nivasi) certificate, or Class 10 and 12 passed from MP schools, is required for the state quota.

The bonds. After admission to a government college you sign a seat-leaving bond (reported at Rs. 30 lakh) and a rural-service bond on non-judicial stamp paper. Confirm the current bond amounts and proformas in the 2026 rule book.

Urgency key: **START NOW** long lead time, apply months ahead. **TIME-BOUND** expires each financial year, must be freshly dated. **STANDARD** straightforward, keep originals ready.

You are in two pools — prepare for both

You are considered for the 85% state quota **and** the 15% All India Quota run by the MCC. The documents below cover both. One difference for AIQ: your OBC certificate must be on the **Central OBC-NCL list in the central format** — an MP OBC certificate works for the state quota but is **rejected** for AIQ. If you plan to use both, get a central-list OBC-NCL certificate as well.

SECTION 1

Documents every candidate needs

Required for both the Madhya Pradesh state quota and the All India Quota, whatever your category. Carry originals plus 3–4 self-attested photocopies of each.

NEET UG 2026 Admit Card

STANDARD

National Testing Agency (NTA)

- WHAT IT IS** Proof you sat the exam; carries the roll number and photo used to match you at the verification desk.
- HOW TO GET IT** Download from neet.nta.nic.in. A fresh admit card is being issued for the 21 June 2026 re-exam — the 3 May card is void.
- WHAT IT COSTS** Free.
- HOW LONG** Available online once released (expected mid-June 2026).

NEET UG 2026 Scorecard / Rank Letter

STANDARD

National Testing Agency (NTA)

- WHAT IT IS** Your percentile, marks and All India Rank — the number the whole allotment runs on.
- HOW TO GET IT** Download from neet.nta.nic.in after results (expected July 2026).
- WHAT IT COSTS** Free.
- HOW LONG** Instant once results are declared.

Class 10 Certificate / Marksheet

STANDARD

Recognised national or state board

- WHAT IT IS** The accepted statutory proof of date of birth — the board certificate, not a municipal birth certificate.
- HOW TO GET IT** You already hold it. If lost, apply to your board for a duplicate well before counselling.
- WHAT IT COSTS** Free if held; duplicate ~Rs.100-500.
- HOW LONG** Instant if held; 2-4 weeks for a board duplicate.

Class 12 Marksheet + Passing Certificate

STANDARD

Recognised national or state board

- WHAT IT IS** Proof you cleared 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotech and English and met the aggregate (50% Open/EWS, 40% SC/ST/OBC, 45% Open-PwBD).
- HOW TO GET IT** You already hold it. Must show individual subject marks.
- WHAT IT COSTS** Free if held.
- HOW LONG** Instant if held.

Government Photo ID

STANDARD

Aadhaar / PAN / Passport / Voter ID / Driving Licence

WHAT IT IS Identity check against the admit card to stop impersonation.

HOW TO GET IT Use any valid, unexpired government ID. The name should match across all your documents.

WHAT IT COSTS Free if held.

HOW LONG Instant if held.

Passport-size Photographs

STANDARD

Same photo as your NTA registration

WHAT IT IS For college records. Must be identical to the photograph uploaded during NEET registration.

HOW TO GET IT Print 8–12 colour copies from the exact file you uploaded to NTA.

WHAT IT COSTS ~Rs.50–150 at a studio.

HOW LONG Same day.

Medical Fitness Certificate

STANDARD

Registered allopathic practitioner (MBBS or higher)

WHAT IT IS Confirms you are fit for clinical training. Some colleges issue it at reporting; others want it in advance.

HOW TO GET IT Get it from a registered MBBS doctor, or at the allotted college's own medical board if they insist on theirs.

WHAT IT COSTS Free at a government hospital; Rs.200–1,000 privately.

HOW LONG Same day.

Birth certificate: needed only as backup if your Class 10 certificate does not print the exact date of birth.

SECTION

Madhya Pradesh eligibility

This unlocks the 85% state quota.

Mool Nivasi (Domicile) Certificate, or 10+12 in MP

START NOW

Competent revenue authority via MP e-District

WHAT IT IS Proof of MP eligibility. Waived if you passed both Class 10 and Class 12 from recognised MP schools.

HOW TO GET IT Apply on the MP e-District / MPeDistrict portal with residence proof, or rely on your MP Class 10 and 12 certificates.

WHAT IT COSTS Nominal.

HOW LONG Allow about 2 weeks; apply early.

Watch out: Non-domiciled candidates without MP 10+12 are pushed to management quota in the later rounds.

Seat-Leaving & Rural-Service Bonds

STANDARD

Candidate (executed after allotment)

WHAT IT IS Commitment bonds: a seat-leaving bond (reported at Rs.30 lakh for government colleges) and a rural-service bond.

HOW TO GET IT Execute the bonds on non-judicial stamp paper in the DME proformas after seat allotment.

WHAT IT COSTS Stamp-paper / notary cost.

HOW LONG At reporting / admission.

Watch out: Bond amounts and proformas change — verify the current figures in the 2026 rule book before reporting.

SECTION

Reservation & fee documents

Only if you are claiming a reserved category.

Caste / EWS Certificate

TIME-BOUND

Competent MP authority via e-District

- WHAT IT IS** Proof of your reserved category for the MP quota. MP gives reserved categories an age relaxation, so accurate DOB on your Class 10 certificate matters.
- HOW TO GET IT** Apply on the MP e-District portal in the prescribed format. EWS is for the current year.
- WHAT IT COSTS** Nominal.
- HOW LONG** About 2 weeks.

Watch out: OBC and EWS certificates are time-limited — get freshly dated ones for this cycle.

SECTION

Special quotas

Only if these apply to you.

Freedom Fighter / Sainik / Govt-School Quota

STANDARD

Respective competent authority

- WHAT IT IS** MP runs specific categories: freedom-fighter ward, ex-servicemen/sainik ward, and MP government-school students.
- HOW TO GET IT** Obtain the certificate the relevant category requires (Collectorate for freedom-fighter; service records for sainik; school proof for government-school quota).
- WHAT IT COSTS** Nominal.
- HOW LONG** Varies; apply early.

Watch out: Each category has its own proof and proforma — confirm in the 2026 rule book.

PwBD Certificate

START NOW

State-specified authority / MCC centre (AIQ)

WHAT IT IS For the Persons with Benchmark Disability horizontal quota.

HOW TO GET IT For the state quota, use the route in the DME rule book with a valid UDID card. For AIQ you need a separate certificate from one of the MCC's roughly 16 designated centres.

WHAT IT COSTS Free at a government facility.

HOW LONG Apply early; slots are limited.

Watch out: A state PwBD certificate does not cover your AIQ PwBD claim, and vice versa.

The Madhya Pradesh checklist

- **Eligibility:** MP mool nivasi certificate, or Class 10 and 12 passed from MP.
- **Bonds:** prepare for the seat-leaving and rural-service bonds on stamp paper after allotment.
- **Category:** current caste/EWS certificates; note the reserved-category age relaxation.
- **Central vs state for AIQ:** MP category certificates are for the state quota; AIQ needs a central-list OBC-NCL certificate.
