



COUNSELLING DOCUMENTATION GUIDE

Rajasthan NEET UG Documents

Every document a Rajasthan candidate needs — the national papers every applicant must carry, plus the state-quota proofs and bonds. What each one is, how to get it, what it costs, and the mistakes that cost a seat.

Covers both pools. As a Rajasthan candidate you are considered for the 85% state quota (Rajasthan NEET UG counselling board) and the 15% All India Quota (MCC). This guide is complete on its own — you do not need any other document to follow it.

START HERE

Rajasthan ties domicile to a parent's ten years plus your five years of study

A Rajasthan bonafide/domicile certificate is the key to the 85% quota, and the test is specific: one parent must have lived continuously in Rajasthan for at least ten years and you must have studied for at least five of those years in a recognised Rajasthan institution. Bonafide residents studying outside the state also qualify. At reporting you also sign bonds and an originals undertaking.

What Rajasthan domicile actually requires

The 10+5 rule. One parent resident in Rajasthan for ten continuous years, and you studied at least five years in a recognised Rajasthan institution during that period. A plain address is not enough.

Bonds and undertaking at reporting. Carry the required bond(s) from the information booklet and the Proforma-1 undertaking that your documents are originals.

Urgency key: **START NOW** long lead time, apply months ahead. **TIME-BOUND** expires each financial year, must be freshly dated. **STANDARD** straightforward, keep originals ready.

You are in two pools — prepare for both

You are considered for the 85% state quota **and** the 15% All India Quota run by the MCC. The documents below cover both. One difference for AIQ: your OBC certificate must be on the **Central OBC-NCL list in the central format** — a Rajasthan OBC/MBC certificate works for the state quota but is **rejected** for AIQ. If you plan to use both, get a central-list OBC-NCL certificate as well.

SECTION 1

Documents every candidate needs

Required for both the Rajasthan state quota and the All India Quota, whatever your category. Carry originals plus 3–4 self-attested photocopies of each.

NEET UG 2026 Admit Card

STANDARD

National Testing Agency (NTA)

- WHAT IT IS** Proof you sat the exam; carries the roll number and photo used to match you at the verification desk.
- HOW TO GET IT** Download from neet.nta.nic.in. A fresh admit card is being issued for the 21 June 2026 re-exam — the 3 May card is void.
- WHAT IT COSTS** Free.
- HOW LONG** Available online once released (expected mid-June 2026).

NEET UG 2026 Scorecard / Rank Letter

STANDARD

National Testing Agency (NTA)

- WHAT IT IS** Your percentile, marks and All India Rank — the number the whole allotment runs on.
- HOW TO GET IT** Download from neet.nta.nic.in after results (expected July 2026).
- WHAT IT COSTS** Free.
- HOW LONG** Instant once results are declared.

Class 10 Certificate / Marksheet

STANDARD

Recognised national or state board

- WHAT IT IS** The accepted statutory proof of date of birth — the board certificate, not a municipal birth certificate.
- HOW TO GET IT** You already hold it. If lost, apply to your board for a duplicate well before counselling.
- WHAT IT COSTS** Free if held; duplicate ~Rs.100-500.
- HOW LONG** Instant if held; 2-4 weeks for a board duplicate.

Class 12 Marksheet + Passing Certificate

STANDARD

Recognised national or state board

- WHAT IT IS** Proof you cleared 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotech and English and met the aggregate (50% Open/EWS, 40% SC/ST/OBC, 45% Open-PwBD).
- HOW TO GET IT** You already hold it. Must show individual subject marks.
- WHAT IT COSTS** Free if held.
- HOW LONG** Instant if held.

Government Photo ID

STANDARD

Aadhaar / PAN / Passport / Voter ID / Driving Licence

WHAT IT IS Identity check against the admit card to stop impersonation.

HOW TO GET IT Use any valid, unexpired government ID. The name should match across all your documents.

WHAT IT COSTS Free if held.

HOW LONG Instant if held.

Passport-size Photographs

STANDARD

Same photo as your NTA registration

WHAT IT IS For college records. Must be identical to the photograph uploaded during NEET registration.

HOW TO GET IT Print 8–12 colour copies from the exact file you uploaded to NTA.

WHAT IT COSTS ~Rs.50–150 at a studio.

HOW LONG Same day.

Medical Fitness Certificate

STANDARD

Registered allopathic practitioner (MBBS or higher)

WHAT IT IS Confirms you are fit for clinical training. Some colleges issue it at reporting; others want it in advance.

HOW TO GET IT Get it from a registered MBBS doctor, or at the allotted college's own medical board if they insist on theirs.

WHAT IT COSTS Free at a government hospital; Rs.200–1,000 privately.

HOW LONG Same day.

Birth certificate: needed only as backup if your Class 10 certificate does not print the exact date of birth.

SECTION

Rajasthan domicile

This unlocks the 85% state quota.

Bonafide / Domicile Certificate of Rajasthan

START NOW

Competent revenue authority (Tehsildar/SDM) via e-Mitra

- WHAT IT IS** The core proof of Rajasthan eligibility under the 10-year parent residence + 5-year study rule.
- HOW TO GET IT** Apply through an e-Mitra centre / the state portal with your and your parent's residence and study proof.
- WHAT IT COSTS** Nominal (around Rs.40-100 via e-Mitra).
- HOW LONG** Allow about 2-3 weeks; apply early.

Watch out: The certificate must reflect the 10+5 condition. Bonafide residents studying outside Rajasthan should carry proof of their Rajasthan residence.

Bonds & Proforma-1 Undertaking

STANDARD

Candidate (executed at reporting)

- WHAT IT IS** Service / seat-leaving bonds named in the information booklet, plus the undertaking that submitted documents are originals.
- HOW TO GET IT** Prepare the bond(s) as specified in the current booklet; sign Proforma-1 at the allotted college (reporting is centralised, e.g. at SMS Medical College, Jaipur).
- WHAT IT COSTS** Stamp-paper / notary cost only.
- HOW LONG** At reporting.

Watch out: Missing or wrongly executed bonds can hold up your admission — read the booklet's bond clause in advance.

SECTION

Reservation & fee documents

Only if you are claiming a reserved category or a fee concession.

Category Certificate (SC/ST/OBC/MBC/EWS)

TIME-BOUND

Competent Rajasthan authority via e-Mitra

- WHAT IT IS** Proof of your reserved category for the Rajasthan quota.
- HOW TO GET IT** Apply via e-Mitra in the prescribed Rajasthan format. OBC/MBC need a current non-creamy-layer status; EWS is for the current year.
- WHAT IT COSTS** Nominal.
- HOW LONG** About 2–3 weeks.

Watch out: OBC/MBC/EWS certificates are time-limited — get freshly dated ones for this cycle.

SECTION

Special quotas

Only if these apply to you.

PwBD Certificate

START NOW

State-specified authority / MCC centre (AIQ)

- WHAT IT IS** For the Persons with Benchmark Disability horizontal quota.
- HOW TO GET IT** For the state quota, use the route in the Rajasthan booklet with a valid UDID card. For AIQ you need a separate certificate from one of the MCC's roughly 16 designated centres.
- WHAT IT COSTS** Free at a government facility.
- HOW LONG** Apply early; slots are limited.

Watch out: A state PwBD certificate does not cover your AIQ PwBD claim, and vice versa.

The Rajasthan checklist

- **Domicile:** the 10-year parent residence + 5-year study certificate — start early via e-Mitra.
- **Bonds:** prepare the booklet's bond(s) and the Proforma-1 originals undertaking before reporting.
- **Category:** current OBC/MBC/EWS certificates, freshly dated.
- **Central vs state for AIQ:** Rajasthan category certificates are for the state quota; AIQ needs a central-list OBC-NCL certificate.
