JOINING ROUND 2 CLOSSES THE DOOR

Once you take a Round 2 seat, you are out of the rounds that follow. Plan for that before you accept.

The deposits

A government medical or dental seat needs Rs 10,000, or Rs 5,000 for reserved categories. A private-dental seat needs Rs 50,000; a private-medical seat needs Rs 2,00,000.

Round 1 and the Round 2 lock

Round 1 allows a free exit if you take no seat. A Round 2 allotment you do not report to forfeits the deposit. And once you join a Round 2 seat, you cannot enter the rounds that follow.

✓ THINK BEFORE JOINING IN ROUND 2

If you are still hoping to upgrade, joining now ends that hope.
