

Delhi MBBS Counselling: Exit Rules

Conducted by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) - DU and IPU quota

Both the 15% all-India and the 85% Delhi-domicile quota for DU and IPU colleges run through the MCC.

What this means for you

Because the MCC runs it, the rules are the all-India rules: a free exit in Round 1, forfeiture for a Round 2 seat you do not join. Domicile eligibility needs Class 11 and 12 studied in Delhi.

The deposit

Registration takes Rs 10,000, or Rs 5,000 for reserved categories, the same as the AIQ government slab. Add a deemed university to your list and the larger Rs 2,00,000 deemed deposit applies.
