## READ THIS CAREFULLY

Haryana gives a penalty-free withdrawal window. It does not give a free pass to abandon an allotted Round 2 seat.

## The withdrawal window

Pull out within the official withdrawal dates and you keep your deposit, in Round 1 or Round 2. Miss the window and the rules change.

## Where it bites

A candidate allotted in Round 2 who simply does not join still forfeits the Rs 1,00,000 deposit. The free exit is the formal withdrawal step, not walking away from a seat. From the mop-up round there is no leniency at all.

## ✓ MARK THE DATES THE DAY THEY PUBLISH

Exiting through the window is free. Exiting by ignoring a seat is not.
