

# Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh MBBS Counselling: Exit Rules

J&K Board of Professional Entrance Examinations (JKBOPEE)

**ELIGIBILITY****UT domicile only****DEPOSIT / GOVT****Rs 10,000****DEPOSIT / PRIVATE****Rs 1,00,000****FREE EXIT****Round 1****DOMICILE ONLY**

The state quota is for valid UT-domicile candidates. Outsiders cannot enter it.

## The basics

A government candidate deposits Rs 10,000, a private candidate Rs 1,00,000. Round 1 allows a free exit, with forfeiture following in the later rounds for a seat you refuse.

## Documents

The verification is strict, and Ladakh candidates need specific annexures. A missing domicile or category paper can cost the seat regardless of rank.

**✓ ASSEMBLE THE ANNEXURES EARLY**

Most J&K rejections are document problems, not merit ones.
