The private deposit depends on the seat type, not your category.

The deposits

Government state-quota seats need a flat Rs 10,000. A private state-quota seat needs Rs 50,000; a management-quota private seat needs Rs 1,00,000. The category and female concessions apply to the registration fee, not the deposit.

Round 1, then Round 2

Round 1 is a free exit. Skip an allotment and your deposit stays safe. From Round 2 a seat you do not join forfeits it in full.

In Round 2 list only what you will join and pay for.
