SILENCE IS A DECISION

After an allotment you must act. Choose upgrade or freeze, or lose the seat by doing nothing.

Upgrade or freeze

Log into the CEE portal after an allotment and pick one. Upgrade accepts the seat for now and keeps you in line for a higher preference. Freeze confirms it as final and takes you out of further allotment.

The cost of doing nothing

Miss the login, or fail to pay the token fee by the deadline, and the allotment is cancelled and you drop out of further processing. The low Rs 5,000 deposit makes the round feel forgiving; the deadlines are not.
