

# Odisha MBBS Counselling: Exit Rules

## LEAVE INSIDE THE WINDOW, OR PAY

A late resignation triggers a penalty the state government sets, not a fixed figure you can plan around.

## Rounds 1 and 2

Skip a Round 1 allotment and you lose the seat, not the deposit, which is refunded if you end with no seat. A Round 2 allotment you do not join forfeits your fees and ends your participation.

## Leaving late

Resign after the final withdrawal deadline and the rulebook withholds any refund and imposes a financial penalty as decided by the state government. Odisha also runs a service bond on stamp paper. The figure is whatever the government order of the day specifies, so read it before you sign.

## ✓ EXIT INSIDE THE WITHDRAWAL WINDOW

After it, the cost is open-ended and set by the state, not by you.
