THE ONE THING TO GET RIGHT

Tamil Nadu treats never joining a seat and joining then quitting as two different acts, with very different costs.

Two kinds of leaving

Miss an allotment without ever joining, and you get a free exit in both Round 1 and Round 2. Join a seat and then resign, and the free exit exists only in Round 1. After that, resignation stops being a quiet exit and becomes something the rulebook charges for.

The deposits

A government-quota seat in a self-financing college needs Rs 30,000. A management-quota seat needs one lakh. Both come back on a clean exit, so the deposit is rarely what hurts you here. The bond is.
