The counselling mirrors Andhra's: A, B and C categories filled through phased web options, on the same deposit-and-phase shape.

⚠ DISCONTINUING AFTER THE NOTIFIED PHASE

Rs 20,00,000 For an MBBS or BDS seat, leaving after the notified phase carries a twenty-lakh penalty and a three-year bar from medical and dental admission in Telangana, enforced through a stamp-paper affidavit.

✓ SETTLE IT BEFORE THE PHASE CLOSES

If there is any chance you will leave for an all-India seat, decide before the notified phase ends.
