The deterrent here is not a forfeitable deposit. It is a penalty for leaving a seat you joined.

No deposit to lose

West Bengal holds no pre-allotment deposit. You pay a registration fee of Rs 2,000, or Rs 1,500 for reserved categories, and your college fees go straight to the institution on joining. With nothing to forfeit, Round 1 is a free exit by default.

⚠ LEAVING A GOVERNMENT SEAT

Rs 1,00,000 Drop out of any state government MBBS college and the penalty is one lakh, with your originals withheld until it is paid. There is no separate post-degree service bond.

✓ BE SURE BEFORE YOU JOIN

The cost here comes only if you join and then leave.
